



## *Ocean Nova*



Built in Denmark in 1992, Ocean Nova was specially designed with an ice strengthened hull to navigate through the ice-choked waters of Greenland. The friendly and informal atmosphere onboard welcomes passengers on bridge around the clock. There is nearly always something to see or search for from the spacious observation decks.

With crisp Scandinavian design, she offers 38 comfortable outside cabins, all enjoying private facilities, including dedicated single, twin and triple cabins. Triple cabins and some twin cabins on upper deck comprise upper and lower berths. All other cabins have two lower berths. All cabins provide a desk, chair, flat screen TV and DVD player and ample storage space.

There is a glass-enclosed observation lounge and presentation room as well as a spacious dining room, bar, library and infirmary with onboard licensed doctor. Meals are served in the dining room (unreserved seating); meanwhile, passengers can relax with a drink, whilst taking in their scenic polar surroundings in the panorama lounge – this is also where onboard specialists conduct insightful presentations on polar flora, fauna and history.

Other amenities onboard include a polar library, stocked with a collection of polar books and DVDs, exercise room, polar boutique and 24 hour beverage service

Zodiac cruising can be enjoyed on each voyage departure. Option kayaking can be booked as an additional activity on select voyages only for an extra charge, meanwhile hiking and snowshoeing are included on select special interest departures.

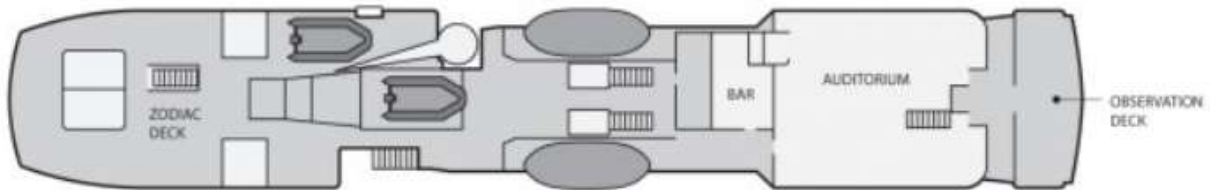

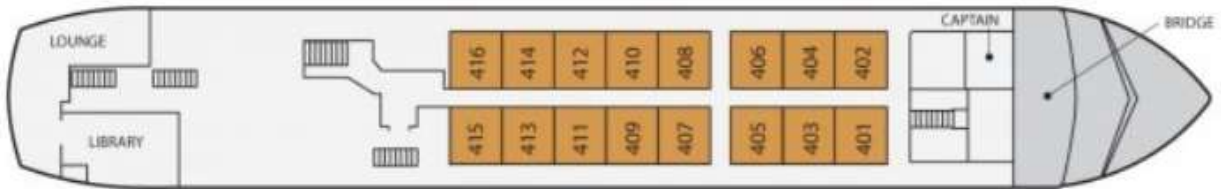

*Top Deck*



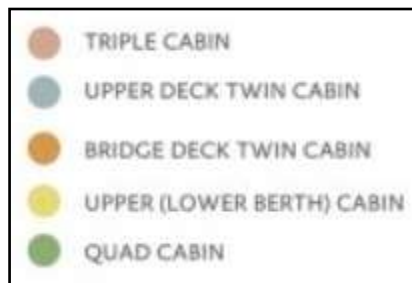
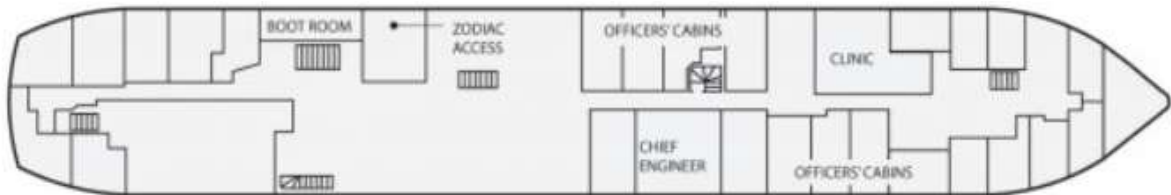
*Bridge Deck*

**Quad Cabins:** Averaging 157 square feet, Quad Cabins are equipped with four twin beds. Located on the Upper Deck, they enjoy exterior views and feature en-suite bathroom facilities.



**Triple Cabins:** Averaging 150 square feet, Triple Cabins are equipped with three twin beds. Located on Upper Deck, they enjoy exterior views and feature en-suite bathroom facilities.



**Bridge Deck Twin:** Averaging 105 square feet, Bridge Deck Twin Cabins are equipped with two twin beds. Located on Bridge Deck, they enjoy exterior views and en-suite bathroom facilities.



**Upper Deck Twin Cabins:** Upper Deck Twin Cabins are equipped with two twin beds. Located on Upper Deck they enjoy exterior views and feature en-suite bathroom facilities.



**Upper (Lower Berth Cabins):** Averaging 88 square feet, Upper Lower Berth Cabins are equipped with one upper berth and one lower berth bed. Located on Upper Deck, they enjoy exterior views and en-suite bathroom facilities.
